Karla Sinkovics/St. Charles Borromeo requesting assistance on June 22nd at 10am with crossing 5th Street + Miami also 7th Street + Miami, 6th & Miami and again 5th & Miami. Karla stated that her request is for police to block the streets as they cross. Chief Feller stated that they have done this for several years and they do not have any issue with helping. Andrea City Clerk Treasurer is requesting the Board of Works approve the purchase of one sensor from Trainfo to be placed at Grant Street railroad crossing. She stated that Trainfo is a company that the Mayor, Tim Fisher and herself have been speaking with sometime now trying to come up with an affordable plan to place these sensors through the town to alert the residents that the crossings are blocked. The city plans on pursuing a grant that will assist in paying for 2 other sensors. Tim added that these sensors will also help provide the data we need to assist in getting the under or overpass paid for. Moved by Board Member McCoy seconded by Board Member Carson MOTION CARRIED

Quit Claim Deed releasing part of parcel number 52-08-35-300-016.000-023 to Gary and Linda Boggs. Dustin stated that prior to the city acquiring this property the Bogg's not knowing that the property they built their garage on was not theirs. Dustin stated that the city has no interest in the property and is willing to turn over the section with their garage to them. The Bogg's have been maintaining this property all along. Request from Bill Shircliff for the east/west alley between Jefferson Ave and Adams Ave to become one way in the easterly direction from Water Street to Wayne Street. Mr. Shircliff states that parents that are dropping their children turn down the alley to get out of the drop off/or pick up line. They state they speed down the alley even though the alley is in bad shape. Bill Sturch stated that he has a sign posted and that does not slow them down. They suggested possibly putting speed bumps in the alley to assist. The question came how the sanitation truck goes down that alley. Moved by Board Member McCoy to table topic to next meeting seconded by Board Member Carson MOTION TABLED

Comments: Pete Sahaidachny questioned that the tree lawn is the city property that must be maintained by the property owner. He questioned, "so if someone got injured in that area is the city responsible or is the property owner's insurance responsible?" Dustin stated it is the property owners responsibility.
