ORDINANCE 19- 2025 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 6, 2014

WHEREAS, the City of Peru has caused public notice to be placed in the Plainer Dealer, formerly known as the Peru Tribune; and WHEREAS, Section 91.17(B) of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances shall be amended to reflect necessary changes; and WHEREAS, the Fire Chief recommends that Section 91.17(B) of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances be amended to ensure public safety and efficient fire protection services; and

WHEREAS, it is essential to public safety that a policy be in place in the event the Peru Fire Department must provide personnel for a fire watch; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Peru, that Section 91.17(B) of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances be amended.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERU, INDIANA, That:

- 1. It is in the best interest of the City of Peru to amend Section 91.17(B) of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances.
- 2. To reflect the necessary amendments to Section 91.17(B) of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances, said Section shall read as follows:

- (B) If a property owner cannot supply fire watch personnel, the City of Peru Fire Department will take over as fire watch personnel; furthermore, the department shall charge back to the property owner, the total cost of the employee's per hour wage, plus any additional overtime compensation as set per the city wage ordinance for that given year.
- ORDINANCE 20 2025 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 40, 1989

WHEREAS, the City of Peru has caused public notice to be placed in the Plainer Dealer, formerly known as the Peru Tribune; and WHEREAS, Section 91.09(B) of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances shall be amended to reflect necessary changes; and WHEREAS, the Fire Chief recommends that Section 91.09(B) of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances be amended to ensure public safety and efficient fire protection services; and

WHEREAS, it is essential to public safety that all fire protection facilities and fire hydrants be installed to the specifications of the Peru Fire Department and Peru Municipal Water Utility; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Peru, that Section 91.09(B) of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances be amended.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERU, INDIANA, That:

- 1. It is in the best interest of the City of Peru to amend Section 91.09(B) of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances.
- 2. To reflect the necessary amendments to Section 91.09(B) of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances, said Section shall read as follows:
- (B) All fire protection facilities and fire hydrants required to be installed hereunder shall be approved by and meet the specifications of the Peru Fire Department and the Peru Municipal Water Utility as to location, connection size, type of material, and the manner of installation. All hydrants shall be equipped with a 5" Storz and 2-2.5" NST connections. All standpipe and sprinkler external connections shall be 5" Storz on a 30-degree angle 36" from the ground. Internal standpipe connections shall be equipped with a 2.5" NST connection with a shut off valve. Construction shall be carried out under the inspection of the fire department and the municipal water utility. When land is developed in such a manner that all or a substantial portion of the building becomes more than a distance of 150 feet from the municipal water supply for fire protection, the developer shall provide fire protection facilities and fire hydrants on the land as shall be determined necessary under this section to provide an adequate water supply.
