ORDINANCE 23-2025 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SALARIES AND WAGES OF THE CIVIL CITY EMPLOYEES AND APPOINTEES FOR THE YEAR 2026. This ordinance reflects a 2.5% increase for all employees except for the fire department whose wage reflects a 15% increase. Moved by Councilperson Fisher, seconded by Councilperson Sahaidachny Vote 5-0, MOTION CARRIED.

A motion was made by Councilperson Fisher, seconded by Councilperson Stevenson to consider Resolution 17-2025 vote 5-0 in favor.

RESOLUTION 17-2025 REDUCTION OF APPROPRIATION CITY OF PERU, MIAMI COUNTY, INDIANA Whereas, it has been shown that certain existing appropriations for budget year 2025 for the City of Peru now have unobligated balances that will not be used for the purposes for which appropriated, it is further resolved that the following existing appropriations be reduced in the following amounts: DEBT SERVICES- GO BOND SERIES 2012 PAYMENT \$97,000.00 and DEBT SERVICE -INTEREST PAYMENT \$7,465.00. Baker Tilly explained that the reduction is needed as only one payment will be made out of the fund for 2025 a reduction will be needed for year 2025 but appropriation will return to the same amount for 2026 Moved by Councilperson Sahaidachny, seconded by Councilperson Stevenson, to suspend the rules and to adopt the Resolution in one meeting. Vote56-0, MOTION CARRIED.
