OLD BUSINESS:

- **ORDINANCE 3 – 2026** AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1, 2015, AS CODIFIED AS § 37.36 OF THE PERU CODE OF ORDINANCES.
- **ORDINANCE 2-2026** An ordinance of the City of Peru authorizing the issuance of waterworks revenue bonds for the purpose of providing funds to pay the cost of certain additions, extensions and improvements to the municipal waterworks of said City, the issuance of revenue bonds to provide for the cost thereof, the collection, segregation and distribution of the revenues of said works, providing for the safeguarding of the interests of the owners of said bonds, other matters connected therewith, including the issuance of notes in anticipation of bonds, and repealing ordinances inconsistent herewith

Power Service (PS)	\$0.001178 per kWh
Security Lighting Service (SL-1)	\$0.000905 per kWh
Municipal Street Lighting (MSL-1)	\$0.000906 per kWh
Traffic Signal Service (TL)	\$0.000168 per kWh
