

Peru Parks Board Meeting-February 9th, 2017

Meeting called to order at 7:08 pm with Kipp Arnold, Greg Quin and Tami Tschiniak present. Kipp motioned to approve the minutes from the previous meeting, Tami seconded, motion carried. Pat Cox sent word that the course was open for 3 days in January with approximately 25 golfers and an approximate income of \$250.00. No further report.

Mike Rhine said they are wrapping up winter maintenance and had submitted his budget usage as of 10/10/16.

Mike Bell said equipment maintenance is 75% completed, he's getting quotes for updated equipment, he put together a quote for mowing the Girls Softball field at West City Park and recommended investing that money (\$954.00) into the playground at West City Park and electrical needs installed at Pavilion #11. He measured Pavilions #7 & #11 for steel roofing and weather permitting, they will start removing downed trees across the creeks. He submitted info on the trash cans w/lids: \$69.99x30 with cable totaling \$2,100.00 and he also submitted an estimate for the slide at the River Walk that needs repaired which totals \$960.30 for parts. He contacted the Rotary Club and set May 27th or June 3rd to paint Pavilion #6 at Davis Park and they would also like to have enough volunteers to spread mulch in the lower park. Mike also passed out copies of the new public park ordinances to the board members which he had received from Police Chief Mike Meeks and Mayor Greer.


In old business Kent Workman said that the Easter Egg Hunt is moving forward and Kipp Arnold passed out a rental form for the board to review and revise for future use.
